

Site Management Safety Training Scheme (SMSTS)

Duration:

Five day block

Group Size:

Maximum of 15 learners per course.

Who should attend?

This five day course is designed for construction site managers, agents, quantity surveyors, and project directors and persons who are, or about to be responsible for planning, organizing, monitoring, controlling and administering groups of staff and workforce.

Course Aims:

The course aims to demonstrate how to meet the ever-increasing demand for evidence of sound health & safety management on site and is listed in the Approved Code of Practice for CDM Regulations as a demonstration of competence in the role of site manager.

Certification:

Upon successful completion of the course the learners will be awarded with a Site Safety PLUS certificate awarded by CITB. The certificate is valid for 5 years, after which the learners must sit a 2 day SMSTS Refresher course to renew the certificate and keep their qualification up to date.
