

Confined Space Awareness

Duration:

Two hours

Group Size:

Maximum of 10 learners per course.

Who should attend?

All persons required to work in confined spaces as part of their employment duties.

Course Aims:

The course aims to teach learners how to competently enter, work in and exit a variety of confined spaces, using escape breathing apparatus as part of a planned emergency procedure.

Course Objectives:

Upon completion of the course the learners will cover the following content: -

- Current legislation
- Hazard identification
- Equipment selection
- Permits to work
- Safe working procedures
- Hygiene
- Gas detection
- Breathing apparatus
- Accident and emergency procedures

Certification:

Upon completion of the course the learners will be required to complete a short theory assignment. Course material and handouts will be supplied. upon successful completion learners will receive a certificate and photo ID card.

Learners must supply their own Personal Protective Equipment (PPE) for this course.
