

Confined Space Entry Course – 2 Day

Duration:

Two days

Group Size:

Maximum of 10 learners per course.

Who should attend?

All persons required to work in confined spaces as part of their employment duties.

Course Aims:

The course aims to teach learners how to determine and work within a confined space where the chance of hazardous atmospheres is high and full working breathing apparatus needs to be worn at all times.

Course Objectives:

Upon completion of the course the learners will cover the following content: -

- Current legislation
- Hazard identification
- Equipment selection
- Permits to work
- Safe working procedures
- Hygiene
- Gas detection
- Use of oxygen escape sets and full breathing apparatus
- Accident and emergency procedures

Certification:

Upon completion of the course the learners will be required to complete a practical assignment, which upon successful completion learners will receive a certificate and photo ID card.

Note: All learners wishing to undertake the course must have Emergency First Aid (1 day) by an accredited provider.

Learners must supply their own Personal Protective Equipment (PPE) for this course.
