

## Fire Safety Awareness in the Workplace

**Duration:**

Three hours

**Group Size:**

Maximum 12 learners

**Who should attend?**

*This course is designed for any employee or manager who may have fire safety and evacuation responsibilities in the workplace.*

**Course Aims:**

*The course is aimed at all staff and is designed specifically to promote fire safety within the workplace. It will demonstrate the causes of fire and introduce safe working practices. It will provide the responsible persons with the knowledge and understanding on what to do in the event of a fire in the workplace and the steps to take to prevent this from happening.*

**Course objectives:**

*On completion of the session learners will:*

- Have a basic understanding of fire and fire behaviour*
- Be aware of the different types of signage used, understand their meaning and the importance of following their instructions.*
- Be aware of potential fire hazards that can occur in the workplace*
- Be aware of what action to take in the event of an emergency*
- Be aware of how to operate common fire extinguishers and the importance of using the right type of extinguisher on each type of fire*

**Certification:**
