Who should attend?

Anyone who operates any type of Mobile Elevated Work Platform (MEWP), such as scissor lifts, boom lifts, or trailer mounted or vehicle mounted boom lifts, should take this course to comply with the duties placed upon employers and employees by law.

Course Aims:

The course aims to ensure learners are aware how to operate any type of Mobile Elevated Work Platform (MEWP)

- Different categories of MEWPs
- Testing and inspection of MEWP's

Learners will take a written test, and following practical training also take a practical assessment. Successful learners will receive a certificate issued by IPAF and a photo I.D. IPAF licence showing the category or categories of MEWP on which they have been trained. The licence is internationally accepted.
