

PASMA Alloy Tower Assembly & Dismantling Course



Duration:

One day

Group Size:

Maximum of 12 learners per course.

Who should attend?

Anyone who works with mobile aluminum scaffold towers should take this course, to comply with the duties placed upon employers and employees by law.

Course Aims:

The course aims to ensure learners are aware how to inspect equipment before using it, and how to erect & dismantle equipment correctly and safely.

Course Objectives:

Upon completion of the course the learners will know: -

- Employer's and employee's legal responsibilities
- Importance of Pre-use inspection
- Safe methods of erection & dismantling

Course Outline:

This course is the standard tower course approved by PASMA, who are the main international body governing scaffold towers. Topics covered include:

- Employer's and employee's legal responsibilities
- Tower components
- Pre-use inspection
- Safe methods of erection & dismantling
- Variances in manufacture
- Common hazards
- Practical training
