

## First Aid at Work (Requalification)

**Duration:**  
Two days



*This course is run over two-days and allows for re-certification of First Aid at Work qualified staff. By arrangement the course can be run on non-consecutive days, for example - one day a week over two weeks.*

**Group Size:**  
Maximum 10 learners

### **Who should attend?**

*Nominated workplace first aiders, whose current FAW qualification is due to expire. Candidates must be physically able to carry out the procedures detailed in the course outline and must attend all sessions to be eligible for assessment.*

*Learners are practically assessed throughout the course and then complete two multiple choice question papers on the final afternoon of the course*
